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SPORTS POLICY

Rationale of the Policy

- ❖ The essential rationale of the policy is to reach out to all registered student participants of the College by addressing their sporting and physical activity requirements.
- ❖ The policy's chief aim is to promote students to undertake all activities that develop health and long lasting life styles.

SPORTS MISSION

- ❖ The Physical Education Department of Asan Memorial College of Arts & Science is dedicated to hold up the development of a sustainable and varied sport and recreation scheme.
- ❖ The College will provide a complete learning experience to its students as it believes that participation in sports competitions and recreation activities form an important part of college education.

SPORTS POLICY

- ❖ The excellent infrastructure for sports activity on campus helps the students to improve their physical and mental welfare.
- ❖ The College Physical Education Department brings out the growing professionals to make students physically, mentally, emotionally, and academically topmost in their field through concentrated sporting programmers and excellent sporting amenities.
- ❖ We offer an atmosphere which facilitates the most favorable competence and effectiveness for the growing active students.
- ❖ We regularly provide the best sporting and training facilities to prepare the enormous prospective lying hidden among the students constantly.

- ❖ Hence, the College endows with education outside the Classroom which consists of Health, Safety and Discipline.

OBJECTIVES

- ❖ The Physical Education Department makes efforts to make the students physically as well as mentally fit by giving proper guidance and training.

PROCEDURES

- ❖ After that the admission, a common circular has been sent to every one of the first year departments asking students their area of interest in sports and games.
- ❖ A circular is issued requesting all first year students to inform in relation to their school level participation in sports and games previously (i.e. whether they have participated in zonal, district, divisional, state level.)
- ❖ The Physical Directors are directly associated with National/State level coaches to impart training for various sports and games.
- ❖ As per the Principal's approval, few students are permitted through sports quota and are eligible to participate in team sports without the selection process.

INTER COLLEGIATE SPORTS EVENTS

- ❖ The selected students are formed as different batches for all events and the proper training is given under the guidance by the Physical Directors.
- ❖ In Some places special practices are in fact necessary; specialized in those particular games/events are identified to train the students.
- ❖ The Management provides sports uniform to the college team players and travelling allowance depending upon the venue and duration of the tournament.

- ❖ The training/practice is planned, not affecting the regular classes. Wherever special training/practice is needed, the same is intimated to the concerned department head/class teacher and the permission is obtained to permit the students.

SELECTION OF STUDENTS

- ❖ As soon as the selection date and venue of the events are finalized; the student participants are short listed as teams with adequate number of substitutes, for each event.
- ❖ Followed by a final list of students is prepared with respect to the year, event, and department.
- ❖ The College Physical Director updates the concerned faculty-in-charge, HOD and Principal regarding all the events.
- ❖ The student participants are asked to fill up the OD forms for taking part in the events. It is permitted by the Physical Director and submitted to the concerned HOD/faculty-in-charge.
- ❖ Depending upon the number of students, the transport facility is arranged on need basis.

REPORT

- ❖ After returning from the Inter-College Sports Event, the Physical Director prepares a detailed Sports Event Report. It consists of the events (sports and games) in which the students have enthusiastically participated. The list will contain the number of rounds students who won along with the complete list of prize winners/runners.
- ❖ The final report is sent to the Principal Office within a week after completion of the event by the Physical Director.

SPORTS DAY

- ❖ Every year in the months of Jan/Feb, the Department of Physical Education of Asan Memorial College of Arts & Science, celebrates the Sports Day.
- ❖ Both Inter- Collegiate and Intra-Collegiate events are planned accordingly.
- ❖ Students' participants are divided into batches depending upon their ability in the events.
- ❖ The Physical Directors discuss with the Principal and HODs to chart out the dates for all events of sports and games without affecting any of the classes. It is displayed in the College and Department notice board.
- ❖ Outside referee (wherever required) are invited to help in conducting the event.
- ❖ The faculty members are also given responsibilities similar to conducting matches, short listing the candidates for conducting events.
- ❖ The students in the College Sports Committee are formed in different batches and they are given work like marking the courts, making the ground ready for matches and helping to conduct events efficiently.
- ❖ After making all the necessary arrangements, the matches/events are conducted as per the chart and the names of the winning team/participants are noted down.
- ❖ In-case of any natural calamities like flood, rainfall, the students are informed as to when the particular or group of sports events would be conducted.

- ❖ The short listing of Running and other Events are completed before the Sports Day celebrations.

Annual Sports Day Event

- ❖ A Grand Annual Sports Day event is held every year after the successful completion of sports events.
- ❖ An eminent sports personality is invited to grace the occasion and give away prizes.
- ❖ At the Intra Collegiate level, an overall Wining Trophy and cash prizes are distributed and laurels were given to the best team, best sports man/woman and best coach.
- ❖ At the inter-college level, a overall trophy and cash prize is given to the best department which has won highest number of medals.
